10. How does **Proverbs 25:2** connect to Bible Prophecy?
11. Why did Jesus speak in Parables in **Matthew 13**?
12. Revelation is in a sense, "written in code", so where has the Holy Spirit 'hidden the codes'?
13. Who are the three women found in Revelation?
14. What is the difference between the "*Wife of God*" and the "*Bride of Christ*"?
