



# TTR Week 4 Bible Devotion: Walking in Freedom

*Theme: Experiencing the victory Christ has already won.*

## Day 22 – Stand Firm in Freedom

📖 *Scripture:* Galatians 5:1 – “It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.”

💡 *Devotion:* Jesus didn’t set us free so we could go back to old chains. Freedom is our new reality—but we must choose to stand firm in it daily.

🙏 *Prayer:* Lord, thank You for the freedom You’ve given me. Help me stand firm and not return to old habits or mindsets.


📝 *Action Step:* Identify one “old chain” you’ve been tempted to return to. Declare in prayer: “*I will not go back. Christ has set me free.*”

## Day 23 – No Condemnation


📖 *Scripture:* Romans 8:1–2 – “Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.”


💡 *Devotion:* Condemnation is one of the enemy’s favorite strongholds. But God’s Word says there is *none* for those in Christ. We walk free, not guilty.


🙏 *Prayer:* Father, thank You that I am not condemned. Help me believe Your Word over the enemy’s accusations.


 *Action Step:* Each time guilt rises today, say out loud: “*No condemnation in Christ.*”

## Day 24 – Life Abundant


 *Scripture:* John 10:10 – “The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.”


 *Devotion:* Strongholds steal, but Jesus gives abundance. True freedom isn’t just about breaking chains—it’s about living fully alive in Him.


 *Prayer:* Jesus, I receive the abundant life You offer. Help me not just to break free but to live free.

 *Action Step:* Write down 3 blessings in your life today. Celebrate the abundance Jesus has given you.

## Day 25 – Greater Is He in You


 *Scripture:* 1 John 4:4 – “The one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world.”


 *Devotion:* Strongholds may seem powerful, but the Spirit of God within us is greater than any force against us. We walk in victory because of who lives in us.


 *Prayer:* Holy Spirit, remind me today that Your power within me is greater than any stronghold or temptation.


 *Action Step:* Speak this aloud today when faced with a struggle: “*Greater is He who is in me!*”

## Day 26 – Armor of God


 *Scripture:* Ephesians 6:10–11 – “Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil’s schemes.”


 *Devotion:* Walking in freedom means staying prepared. God equips us with spiritual armor to protect us and keep us standing firm.


 *Prayer:* Lord, clothe me in Your armor today. Help me to stand strong against the enemy’s lies.


 *Action Step:* Pray through each piece of the armor of God (Ephesians 6:14–17) and picture yourself putting it on.

## Day 27 – The Lord My Fortress


 *Scripture:* Psalm 18:2 – “The Lord is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer.”


 *Devotion:* Strongholds may feel like fortresses, but God is a greater fortress—one of safety, strength, and deliverance. Freedom is found in Him alone.


 *Prayer:* God, You are my fortress and protector. I run to You for safety and strength.


 *Action Step:* Take a moment today to find a quiet place. Sit in stillness, repeating: “*The Lord is my fortress.*”

## Day 28 – Reflection: Testify of His Freedom

 *Scripture:* Psalm 107:2 – “Let the redeemed of the Lord tell their story—those he redeemed from the hand of the foe.”

 *Devotion:* Testimony is powerful. When we share what God has done, it not only strengthens us but helps others believe for freedom too.

 *Prayer:* Lord, thank You for the victories You’ve given me. Give me boldness to share my story for Your glory.

 *Action Step:* Write down one testimony of freedom God has given you so far in this journey. If possible, share it with a trusted friend.
