Each day includes: Scripture • Reflection Thought • Prayer Prompt

## WEEK 1 — The Promise of a Savior

### DAY 1 — The First Promise

 *Genesis 3:15*

**Reflection:** God promised a Redeemer from the very beginning.

**Prayer:** Thank God for His rescue plan.

### DAY 2 — The Promise to Abraham

 *Genesis 12:1–3*

**Reflection:** Jesus is the blessing for all nations.

**Prayer:** Ask for a heart that trusts God's timing.

### DAY 3 — The Coming King

 *Genesis 49:10*

**Reflection:** Jesus is the eternal ruler foretold.

**Prayer:** Surrender your plans to God's leadership.

### DAY 4 — The Prophecy of the Virgin Birth

 *Isaiah 7:14*

**Reflection:** God works in miraculous ways.

**Prayer:** Ask God to renew your sense of wonder.


### DAY 5 — Light in the Darkness

 *Isaiah 9:2–7*

**Reflection:** The world waited for the Light—now He lives in you.

**Prayer:** Pray for God's light to shine through you.

### DAY 6 — The Branch From Jesse

 *Isaiah 11:1–5*

**Reflection:** Jesus brings righteousness and peace.

**Prayer:** Ask for a spirit of wisdom and understanding.

## **DAY 7 — The Shepherd-King**


 *Micah 5:2–5*

**Reflection:** Jesus leads with strength and tenderness.

**Prayer:** Commit your heart to follow your Good Shepherd.

## **WEEK 2 — The Arrival of Jesus**


### **DAY 8 — The Forerunner**

 *Luke 1:5–17*

**Reflection:** John prepared the way—how can you prepare room for Jesus?

**Prayer:** Ask God to remove distractions this season.


### **DAY 9 — Mary’s Calling**

 *Luke 1:26–38*

**Reflection:** Mary’s “yes” changed history.

**Prayer:** Offer God your humble obedience.

### **DAY 10 — Mary’s Song**

 *Luke 1:46–55*

**Reflection:** Worship is the right response to God’s plan.

**Prayer:** Praise God for His mercy.

### **DAY 11 — Joseph’s Obedience**

 *Matthew 1:18–25*

**Reflection:** Joseph obeyed even when it didn’t make sense.

**Prayer:** Ask God for courage to follow Him.


### **DAY 12 — The Birth of John**

 *Luke 1:57–66*

**Reflection:** God keeps His word, always.

**Prayer:** Pray for strengthened faith.

## DAY 13 — Zechariah's Prophecy

 *Luke 1:67-79*

**Reflection:** Jesus comes to guide us into peace.

**Prayer:** Ask God for peace in your heart and home.

## DAY 14 — The Journey to Bethlehem

 *Luke 2:1-5*

**Reflection:** God uses ordinary events to fulfill extraordinary plans.

**Prayer:** Ask God to help you see His hand in daily life.

# WEEK 3 — The Birth of Jesus & Our Response

## DAY 15 — The Savior Is Born

 *Luke 2:6-7*

**Reflection:** The King came in humility so He could be accessible to all.

**Prayer:** Thank Jesus for coming near.

## DAY 16 — Good News of Great Joy

 *Luke 2:8-14*

**Reflection:** Christmas is the announcement of joy for every person.

**Prayer:** Pray that God restores joy in your life.

## DAY 17 — The Shepherds Seek Jesus

 *Luke 2:15-20*

**Reflection:** Those who seek Him find Him.

**Prayer:** Ask God for a hunger to pursue Him daily.


## DAY 18 — Simeon's Praise

 *Luke 2:25-35*

**Reflection:** Jesus fulfills our deepest longings.

**Prayer:** Wait on God with patient hope.


## DAY 19 — Anna's Testimony

 *Luke 2:36–38*

**Reflection:** A life devoted to God overflows into worship and witness.

**Prayer:** Pray for a spirit of devotion.


## **DAY 20 — The Wise Men Worship**

 *Matthew 2:1–12*

**Reflection:** True worship includes giving our best.

**Prayer:** Offer Jesus your time, gifts, and heart.

## **DAY 21 — The Word Became Flesh**

 *John 1:1–14*

**Reflection:** God didn't just send a message—He came Himself.

**Prayer:** Invite Jesus to dwell fully in your life this Christmas.

**Day 12** – *Luke 1:57–66*

**Day 13** – *Luke 1:67–79*

Jesus guides us into peace.

**Day 14** – *Luke 2:1–5*

God uses ordinary moments to fulfill extraordinary plans.

**Day 15** – *Luke 2:6–7*

The Savior came in humility so we could come to Him freely.

**Day 16** – *Luke 2:8–14*
